- **Examiners:** Conflicts counsel to the chapter 11 examiner in the *Caesar's Entertainment* chapter 11 cases in connection with the examiner's investigation of certain multibillion-dollar prepetition transactions, and preparation of his final report; examiner and counsel to the examiner in the *North General Hospital* chapter 11 case in the Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of New York; and examiner and counsel to the examiner in the *Nellson Nutraceutical* chapter 11 case in Delaware.
